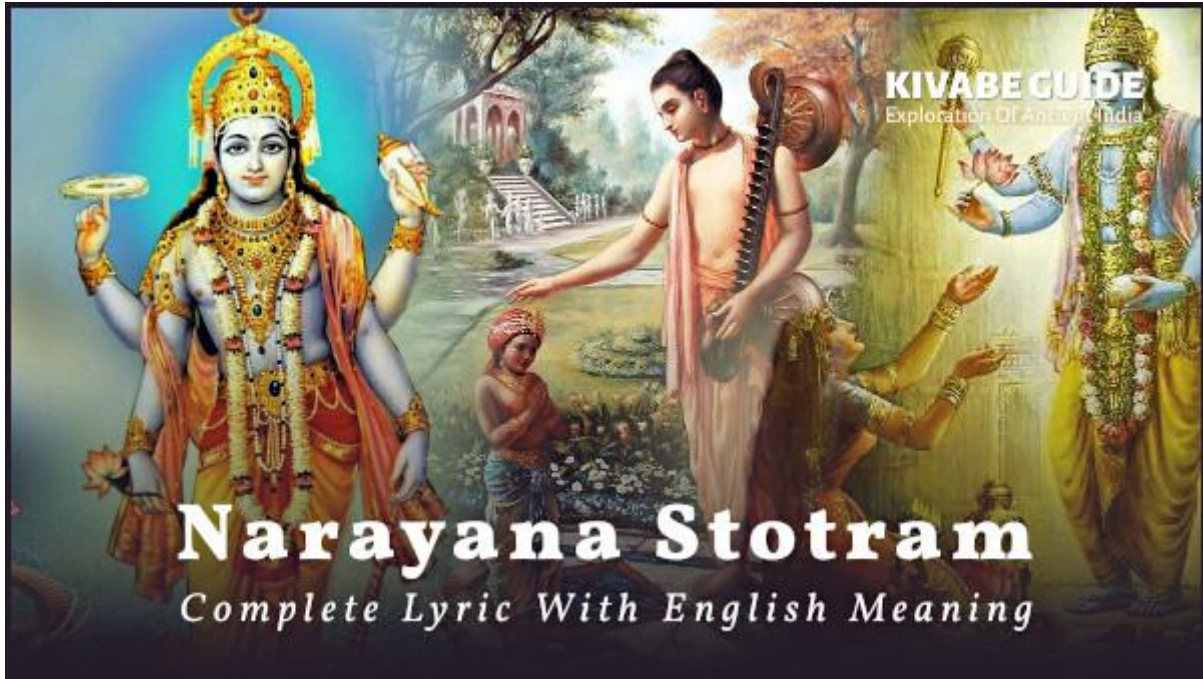


# Complete Narayana Stotram Lyrics With English Meaning

## Narayana Stotram Lyrics With English Meaning

**nārāyaṇa nārāyaṇa jaya gōvinda harē ||**

**nārāyaṇa nārāyaṇa jaya gōpāla harē ||**

**Meaning:**

- Victory to Lord Narayana, who is Lord Govinda and the protector.
- Victory to Lord Narayana, who is Lord Gopala and the protector.

**karuṇāpārāvāra varuṇālaya gambhīra nārāyaṇa || 1**

**navanīradasañkāśa kṛtakalikalmaṣanāśana nārāyaṇa || 2**

**Meaning:**

- Oh ocean of mercy, Of God who is as majestic as the sea - *Narayana*.
- Oh Lord, who is similar to the rich cloud, Oh Lord who destroys the ills of the Kali Age - *Narayana*.

**yamunātīravihāra dhṛtakaustubhamaṇihāra nārāyaṇa || 3**

**pītāambaraparidhāna surakalyāṇanidhāna nārāyaṇa || 4**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who played on the shores of Yamuna, Oh Lord who wore the chain made of Kousthubha. *Narayana*.
- Oh Lord who dresses in the yellow silk, Oh Lord who is the storehouse of good to devas. *Narayana*.

**mañjulaguñjābhūṣa māyāmānuṣavēṣa nārāyaṇa || 5**

**rādhā:'dharamadhurasika rajanīkarakulatilaka nārāyaṇa || 6**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who wears Garland of pretty Gunja seeds, Oh Lord who takes the form of the invisible man. *Narayana*.
- Oh Lord who enjoys the honey from the lips of Radha, Oh lord who is the crown of the princes of the dynasty of the moon. *Narayana*.

**muralīgānavinōda vēdastutabhūpāda nārāyaṇa || 7**

**vārijabhūṣābharāṇa rājīvarukmiṇīramaṇa nārāyaṇa || 8**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who enjoys playing the flute, Oh lord whose feet are praised by Vedas, *Narayana*.
- Oh Lord who wears the peacock feathers, Oh Lord who danced on the head of the snake. *Narayana*.

**jalaruhadalanibhanētra jagadārambhakasūtra nārāyaṇa || 9**

**pātakarajanīsamhāra karuṇālaya māmuddhara nārāyaṇa || 10**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who makes the lotus as an ornament, Oh Lord who plays with the daughter of lotus flower. **Narayana.**
- Oh lord who destroys the darkness of sin, Oh Lord who elevates me by his mercy. **Narayana.**

**aghabakakṣayakāmsārē kēśava kṛṣṇa murārē nārāyaṇa || 11**

**hāṭakanibhapītāmbara abhayaṁ kuru mē māvara nārāyaṇa || 12**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who killed Agha and Bhaga, Oh Lord who is the enemy of Kamsa, Oh Kesava, Oh Krishna Oh enemy of Mura. **Narayana.**
- Oh lord who wears gold like yellow silks, Please give me protection oh Consort of Lakshmi. **Narayana.**

**daśaratharājakumāra dānavamadasaṁhāra nārāyaṇa || 13**

**gōvardhanagiri ramaṇa gōpīmānasaharaṇa nārāyaṇa || 14**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who is the son of king Dasaratha, Oh Lord who killed the pride of Asuras. **Narayana.**
- Oh Lord who pleased the Govardhan mountain, Oh Lord who stole the minds of Gopis. **Narayana.**

**sarayūtīravihāra sajjanarṣimandāra nārāyaṇa || 15**

**viśvāmitramakhatra vividhaparāsucaritra nārāyaṇa || 16**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who plays in the banks of Sarayu, Oh Lord who is like a wish giving tree to the good, **Narayana.**
- Oh Lord who saved the Yoga of Viswamitra, Oh Lord who has different histories. **Narayana.**

**dhvajavajrāṅkuśapāda dharaṇīsutasahamōda nārāyaṇa || 17**

**janakasutāpratipāla jaya jaya saṁsmṛtīlīla nārāyaṇa || 18**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord whose feet have symbols of flag and goad, Oh Lord who was made happy by the daughter of earth. **Narayana.**

- Oh Lord who waited on the daughter of Janaka, Victory and victory to him who enjoys plays of life. *Narayana.*

**daśarathavāgdhṛtibhāra daṇḍakavanasañcāra nārāyaṇa || 19**

**muṣṭikacāṇūrasamhāra munimānasavihāra nārāyaṇa || 20**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who obeyed Dasaradha's words, Oh Lord who traveled in Dandaka. *Narayana.*
- Oh Lord who killed Mushtika and Chanura, Oh Lord who lives in the minds of sages. *Narayana.*

**vālinigrahaśaurya varasugrīvahitārya nārāyaṇa || 21**

**mām muralikara dhīvara pālaya pālaya śrīdhara nārāyaṇa || 22**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who killed the valorous Vali, Oh Lord who helped the good Sugreva, *Narayana.*
- Oh valorous Lord who played the flute, Please help us, help us, the consort of Lakshmi. *Narayana.*

**jalanidhibandhanadhīra rāvaṇakaṇṭhavidāra nārāyaṇa || 23**

**tāṭakamardana rāma naṭaguṇavividhadhanāḍhya nārāyaṇa || 24**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who constructed a dam across the sea, Oh Lord who cut off the necks of Ravana, *Narayana.*
- Oh Lord who killed the pride of Thataka, Oh Lord who is praised by music and dance by Devas.

**gautamapatnīpūjana karuṇāghanāvalōkana nārāyaṇa || 25**

**sambhramasītāhāra sākētapuravihāra nārāyaṇa || 26**

**Meaning:**

- Oh Lord who was worshiped by the wife of Gautama, Oh Lord who has a look which is filled with mercy. *Narayana.*
- Oh Lord who stole the mind of Sita, Oh Lord who lived in the city of Ayodhya. *Narayana.*

acalōddhr̥ticañcatkara bhaktānugrahatatpara nārāyaṇa || 27

naigamagānavinōda rakṣitasuprahlāda nārāyaṇa || 28

Meaning:

- Oh Lord who was able to lift a mountain, Oh Lord who is interested in blessing devotees, *Narayana*.
- Oh Lord who is pleased with the Sama gana, Oh Lord who saved the Rakshasas and Prahlada. *Narayana*.
